## Sunday School Proposed Options:

## Option A (current programming):

Preschool Class (Ages 3-7)
Clipboards for Ages 7+
Pro:

- Provides a class for the younger more restless children
- Average Attendance 5 children (majority in Kindergarten)

Con:

- Volunteers less likely to teach this age group
- No Sunday School Class for Elementary children (in- service)
- Requires 1 Teacher \& 1 Assistant


## Option B:

Preschool Class (Ages 3-5)
Elementary Class (Grades 1-4)
Pro:

- Provides age focused class for both age groups
- Elementary Average Attendance 4 children

Con:

- Requires 2 Teachers \& 2 Assistants every Sunday


## Option C:

Mixed Ages Elementary Class
(Kindergarten - Grade 4) or (Ages 5-10)
Pro:

- Larger class size with average attendance of 8-9 children
- Requires 1 Teacher \& 1 Assistant
- Majority of children who currently attend fall into this age group


## Con:

- Wider spread of children at different learning levels
- No Programing for children under 5
*Potential to offer clipboards on long weekends or when 2 leaders are not available
